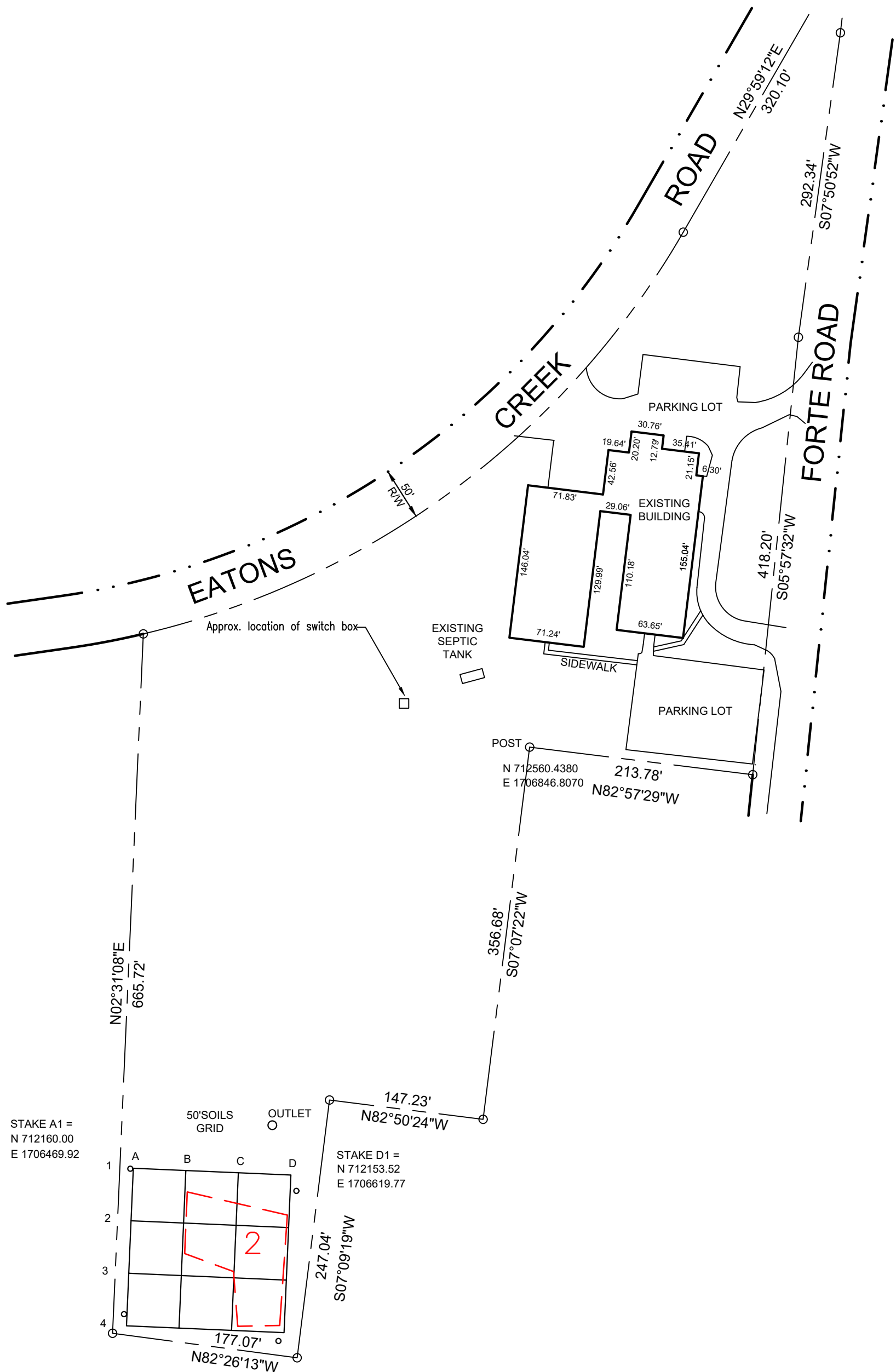

DO NOT IMPLEMENT THIS PLAN WITHOUT READING AND UNDERSTANDING ATTACHED SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS SHEET
Residence must be restricted to 2 bedrooms maximum. Grid stakes must remain in place until system is installed and approved. Filling or cutting of soil within 25 feet of disposal field areas may void approval. Approval expires in 2 years from date of issuance.



If indicated, areas 1 and 2 are required for the soil absorption system. The initial system is to be installed within the boundaries of area number 1 with area number 2 being held in reserve for future use, if necessary. These areas are to remain undisturbed in their natural condition where no cut, fill, driveway, or waterline is allowed. The installation of the system shown gives no assurance that it will function satisfactorily and the owner remains responsible for keeping generated sewage from creating a health hazard. If desired, the owner may contact an engineer to design a different system and submit plans to the Metropolitan Health Department for review and approval.
